

J.W. Coon Uniform Dress Code (Updated 6/2/15)

Belts: Belts are required for ALL students wearing pants, skirts, shorts, or skorts with belt loops.

Girls:

Shirts: Plain white, black, navy blue or light blue polo, oxford style shirt or turtleneck (all shirts must have a collar)

Slacks, shorts, skirts, skorts, jumpers: navy, khaki, or black (No cargo style bottoms). All bottoms must adhere to the “finger tip” test as described in the student handbook.

Shoes: Rubber-soled shoes (No flip flops, wheelies, or high heels)

Socks: ankle, knee high, tights, hose (NON-decorative) colors: white, black, navy, khaki, or tan

Sweaters: Navy or white (pullover or cardigan)

Boys:

Shirts: Plain white, black, navy blue or light blue polo, oxford style shirt or turtleneck (all shirts must have a collar)

Slacks/shorts: navy, khaki, or black (No cargo style bottoms) All bottoms must adhere to the “finger tip” test as described in the student handbook.

Shoes: Rubber-soled shoes (No flip flops or wheelies)

Socks: ankle or knee high (NON-decorative) colors: white, navy, khaki, or tan

Sweaters: Navy or white (pullover or cardigan)

All Students: If a student needs to wear a sweater or jacket in the classroom it must be a uniform color. Winter coats do not have to be uniform colors but will not be worn during class time only at recess when going outdoors. J.W. Coon Spirit Shirts with uniform bottoms (NO jeans) will be permitted on Fridays. These shirts will be available for purchase at the beginning of the school year. Students will be allowed to wear casual attire on special occasions, such as dance and picture days. “Dress Down” days will also be used as an incentive for PBIS performance.
